GENERAL OVERVIEW



Agreement on the Multinational Peace Force South-Eastern Europe (MPFSEE Agreement) was signed on 26 September 1998 in Skopje and its Additional Protocols as follows:

- 1. First Additional Protocol 12 of January 1999 Athens,**
- 2. Second Additional Protocol 30 of November 1999 Bucharest,**
- 3. Third Additional Protocol 21 June 2000 Athens,**
- 4. Fourth Additional Protocol 11 December 2002 Rome,**
- 5. Fifth Additional Protocol 21 October 2009 Sofia,**
- 6. Sixth Additional Protocol 12 June 2019 Skopje.**

All Additional Protocols are into force except the sixth.

AGREEMENT ON THE MULTINATIONAL PEACE FORCE SOUTH-EASTERN EUROPE

The States-Parties to this Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,

Reaffirming their dedication to the purposes and principles provided by the United Nations Charter,

Cognizant of the fact that, politico-military co-operation has become a key element in strengthening the European capabilities in the fields of security and defense,

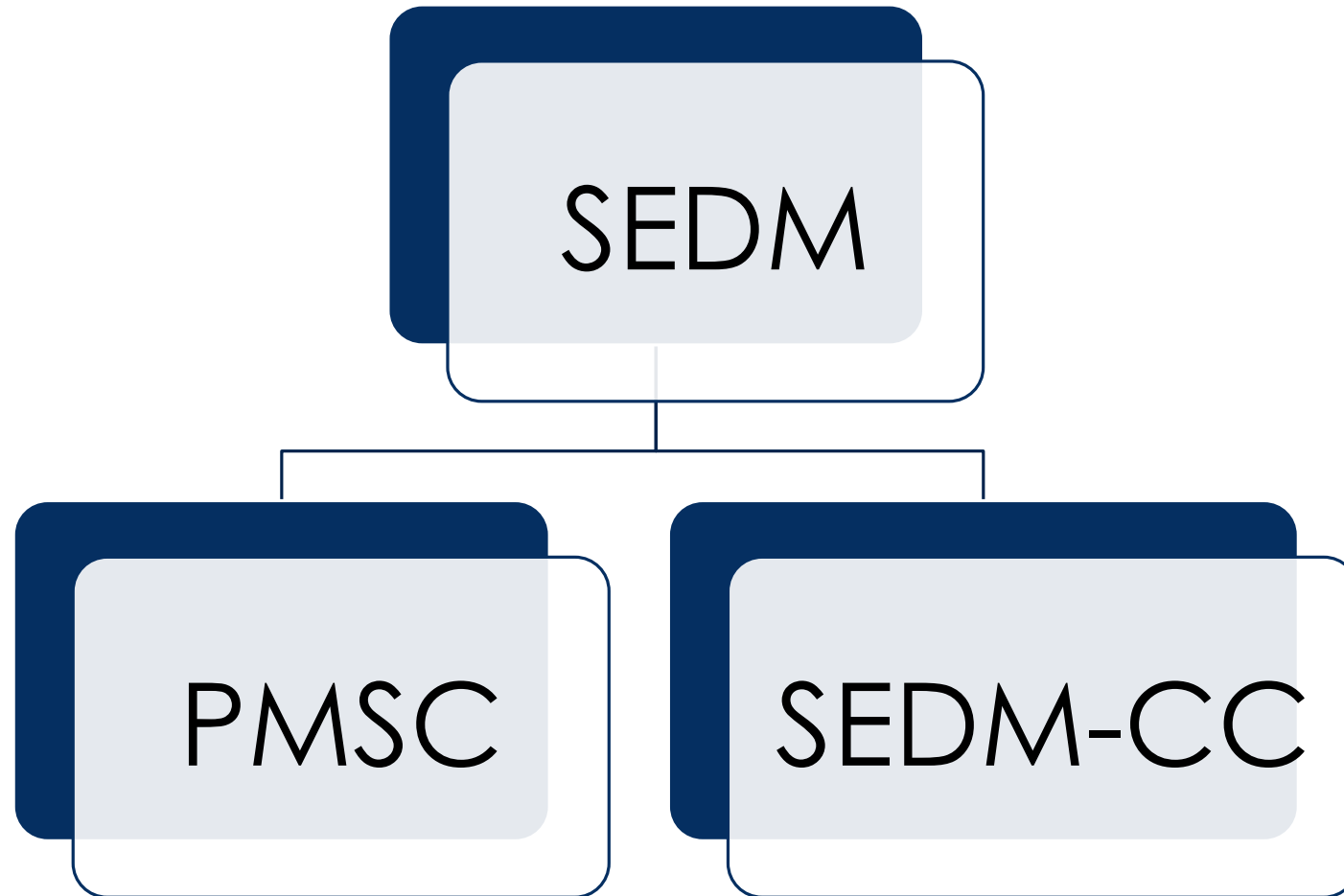
Believing that co-operation and dialogue among the countries of the region of South-Eastern Europe must be further developed,

Wishing to contribute to the enhancement of interoperability,

Considering their commitment to contribute to regional security and stability, and to foster good neighborly relations among the countries in South-Eastern Europe in the context of the Southeastern Europe Defence Ministerial (SEDM) process, the Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council (EAPC) and in the spirit of Partnership for Peace (PfP), have agreed as follows:



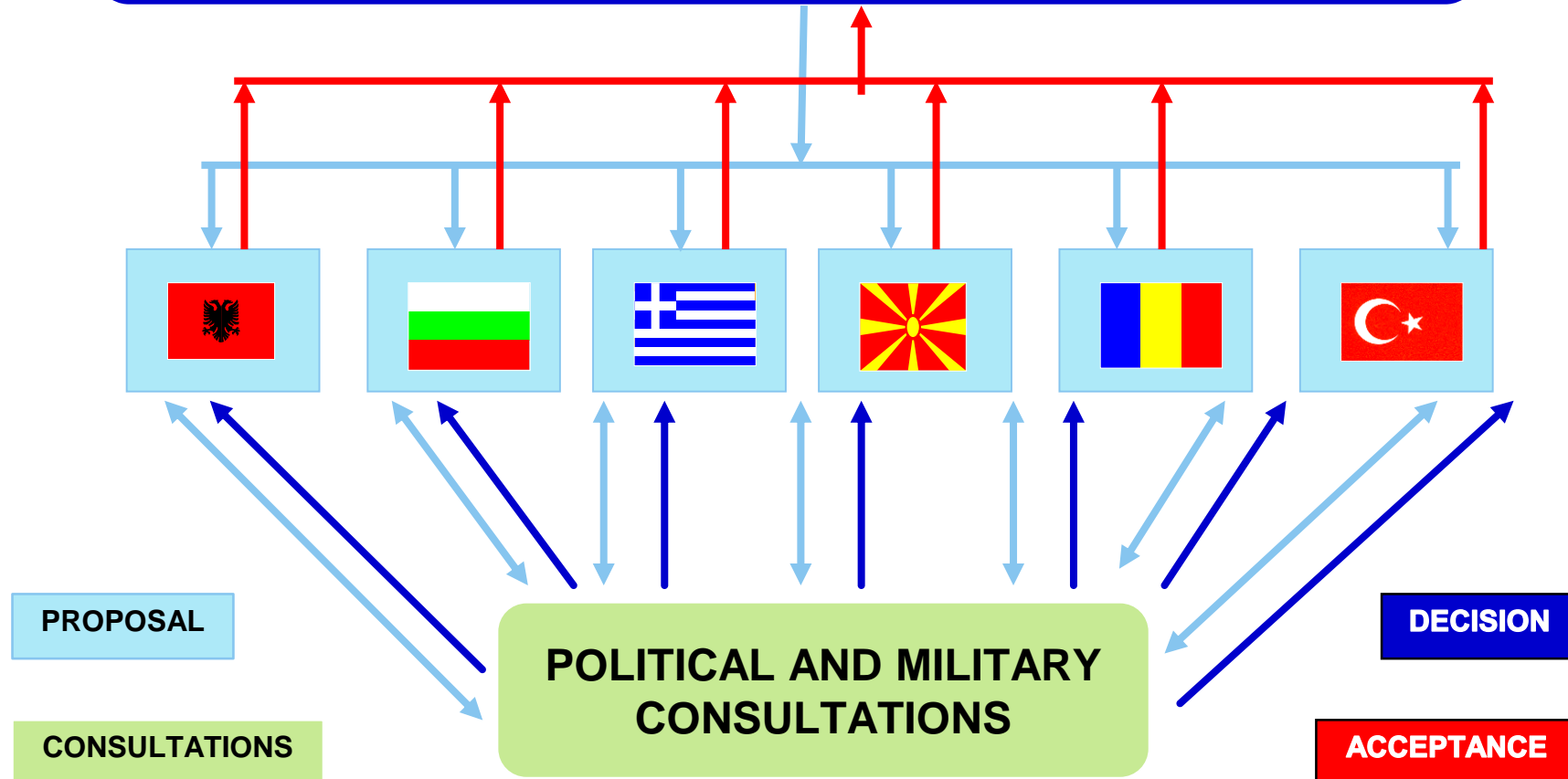

Activities of the MPFSEE are consistent with the purposes and the principles of the United Nations Charter

- **Is neither directed against any third state nor intended to form a military alliance of any form against any country or a group of countries**
- **Is transparent and open to the Nations in the region, “able and willing” to contribute constructively at any later stage**
- **Will be in line with and supportive of PfP programs which aim at the improvement of the regional cooperation within PfP and shall allow essential cooperation within the framework of the UN, NATO, OSCE and EU**

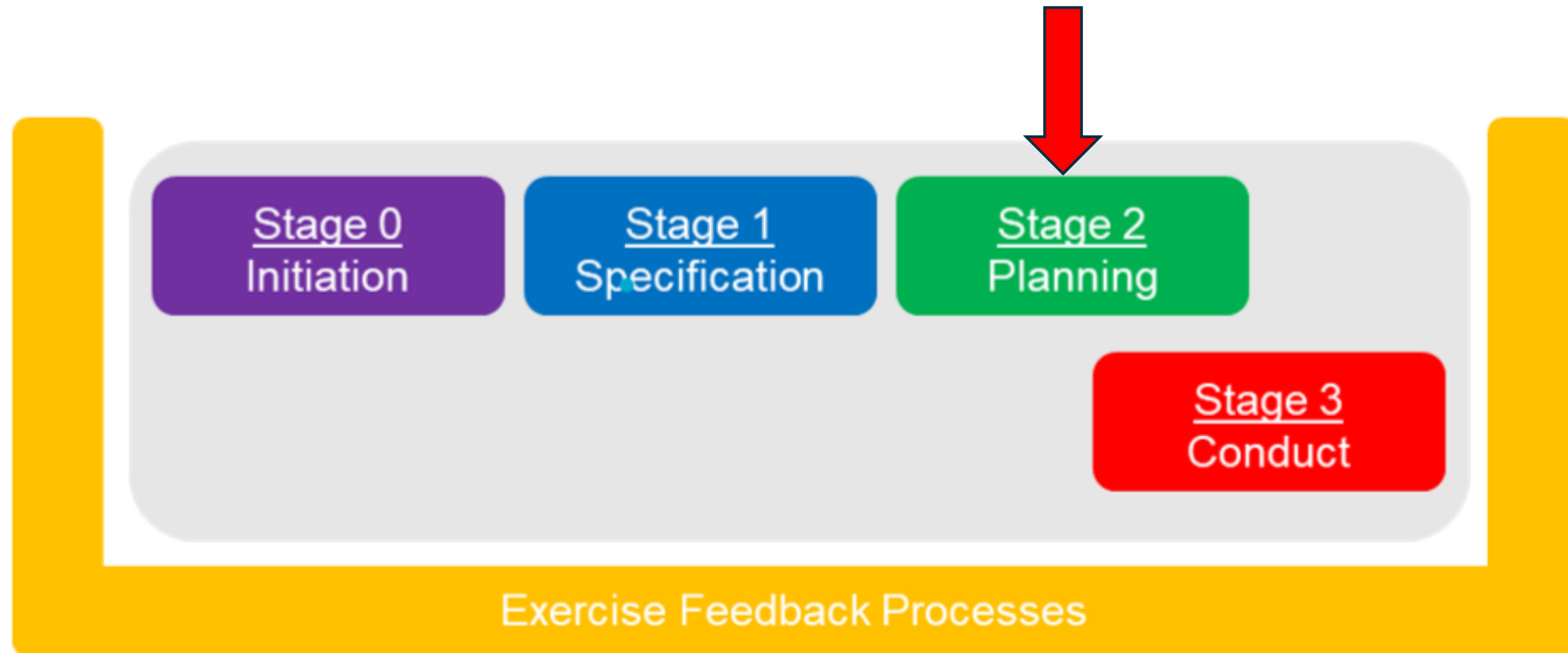


Figure 1-1 – Exercise Process stages

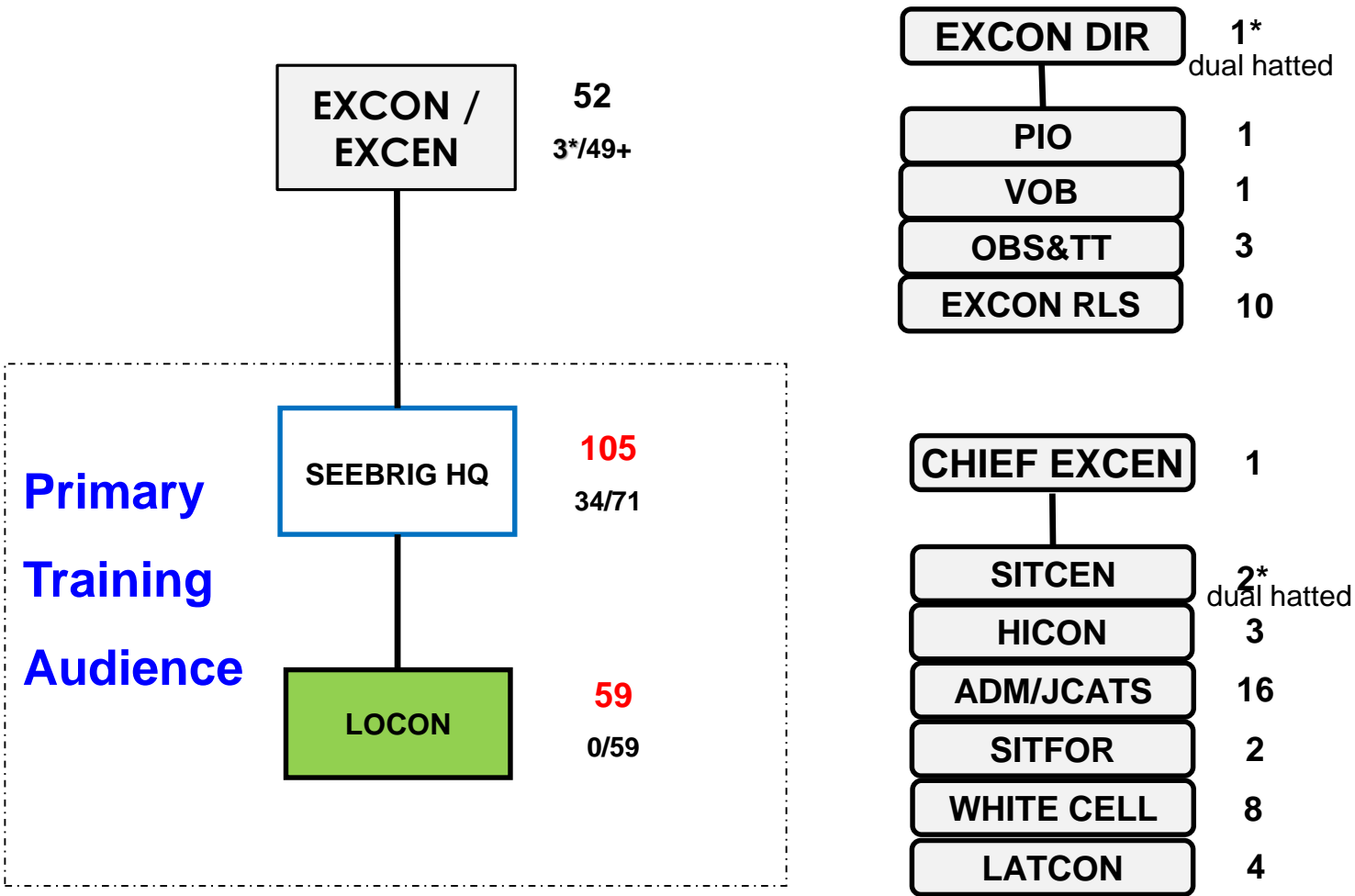

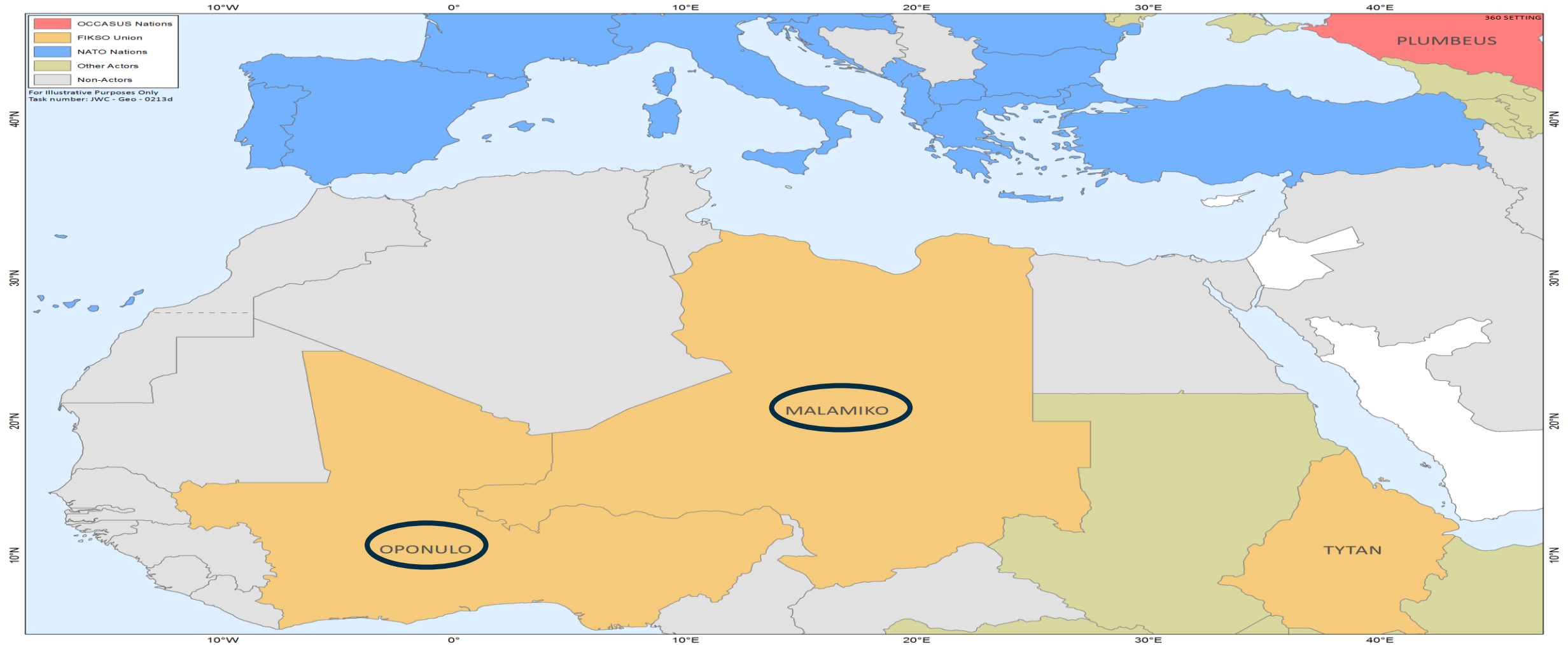

Geostrategic Situation

MALAMIKO

- ✓ Is the largest country in Africa and has the 10th largest proven oil reserves in the world.
- ✓ Malamiko was founded with the merger of three independent countries which were at a time colonies of Italy (Yabil) and France (Regin and Dach).
- ✓ 1969-2011 state governed by a former Army Colonel, Minyar Gammalar, who first took power in Yabil following a bloodless military coup.
- ✓ The Arab Spring which was a wave of protests, uprising and unrest that spread across Arabic-speaking countries in North Africa and the Middle East, emerging from Tunisia in 2010, rapidly disrupted the stability of Malamiko.
- ✓ In early 2011, a civil war broke out.
- ✓ September 2011, the United Nations sent a Support Mission to Malamiko (UNSMIM).
- ✓ Since 1980, Malamiko has developed its defense capabilities and its armed forces at a similar pace to its eastern and western neighbors with the support of Plumbeus.

Step 2 – Mission Analysis. The purpose of step 2 is to understand the situation and the mission. Step 2 has two sub-steps, not sequential but **simultaneous**:

- **Sub-Step 2A – Order Analysis.** The purpose of sub-step 2A is to understand the assigned mission.
 - ☐ Analyze the higher commander's order (one echelon up).
 - ☐ Develop (a restated) mission statement.
 - ☐ Formulate a commander's initial intent.
 - ☐ Develop an additional planning guidance to the staff.
 - ☐ Brief the staff (Order Analysis Briefing).
- **Sub-Sep 2B – Evaluation of Factors.** The purpose of sub-step 2B is to understand the situation.
 - ☐ Staff Analysis on specific parts of the order and annexes.
 - ☐ Perform IPOE.
 - ☐ Review troops and support available to identify capability shortfalls and vulnerabilities to protect.
 - ☐ Review and update time available to plan, prepare, execute and assess the upcoming operation.
 - ☐ Identify risks and begin risk assessment.
 - ☐ Develop CCIRs.
 - ☐ Develop the Initial intelligence collection plan (ICP).
 - ☐ Prepare and present the mission analysis briefing.
 - ☐ Develop and issue additional commander's planning guidance (CPG).
 - ☐ Develop and issue a WNGO.
 - ☐ Deliver an initial lower commanders back brief.

Step 3 – COA Development.

The purpose of the COA development step is to develop one or more options (the how) to accomplish the mission.

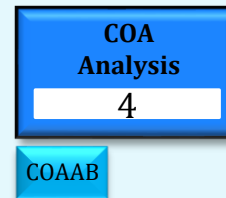

Step 4 – COA Analysis.

The purpose of COA analysis is to enable commanders and staffs to identify difficulties, coordination issues, or probable consequences of planned actions for each COA being considered. It helps them think through the tentative plan.

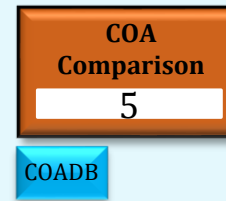

Step 5 – COA Comparison.

The purpose of the COA comparison is to compare friendly COA against ACOA in an objective manner in order to evaluate COAs independently, using the criteria approved by the commander. The goal is to identify the strengths and weaknesses of COAs, enable selecting a COA with the highest probability of success, and further developing it into an OPLAN or OPORD.

LOGISTICS IN MPFSEE AGREEMENT

- ❖ All operational and logistic aspects related to SEEBRIG activities are to be conducted/developed, in principle and where possible, in accordance with NATO's STANAGs
- ❖ Logistics, in principle, is a national responsibility
- ❖ Each Nation is responsible for the logistic support of its own troops including strategic movement during the deployment of SEEBRIG



SEEBRIG LOGISTICS CONCEPT



LOGISTICS IN MPFSEE AGREEMENT

❖ Participating Nations

- Separate agreements/MOUs could be concluded, on a case-by-case basis, to specify the principles for providing logistic support during operations

❖ COMSEEBRIG

- During deployment is responsible for the control of the multinational logistic elements and resources in SEEBRIG
- May be authorized by PMSC, to sign Technical Agreements or other necessary mission-related arrangements



SEEBRIG LOGISTICS CONCEPT



LOGISTICS IN MPFSEE AGREEMENT

- ❖ Each maneuver battalion is to be composed of 2 or 3 companies, combat support and combat service support units if and as required and should have the capabilities such as:
 - Fire support, including organic mortar and medium range antitank weapons,
 - Engineer capabilities,
 - Logistic and medical support,
 - Communications, in principle, in accordance with NATO STANAG's
- ❖ Each battalion must deploy with a logistic unit capable of carrying out first and second line logistic support



SEEBRIG LOGISTICS CONCEPT



LOGISTIC PARAMETRES

- ❖ Units have to deploy with their National Support Elements (NSEs)
- ❖ NSEs functions: General maintenance, Resupply, Transportation, General stores management, Distribution & handling of all first and second line battalion stores, Role 1 and limited Role 2 medical support
- ❖ Stock Level: Will be defined in the OPLAN/OPORD. Support of the mission for a minimum of 6 months
- ❖ Medical: Units (Role 1) / Na-2 Medical Platoon (Role 2)
- ❖ Field Services (food, water, clothing repair & replacement, shower, laundry, waste disposal): National responsibility, if there's no HNS

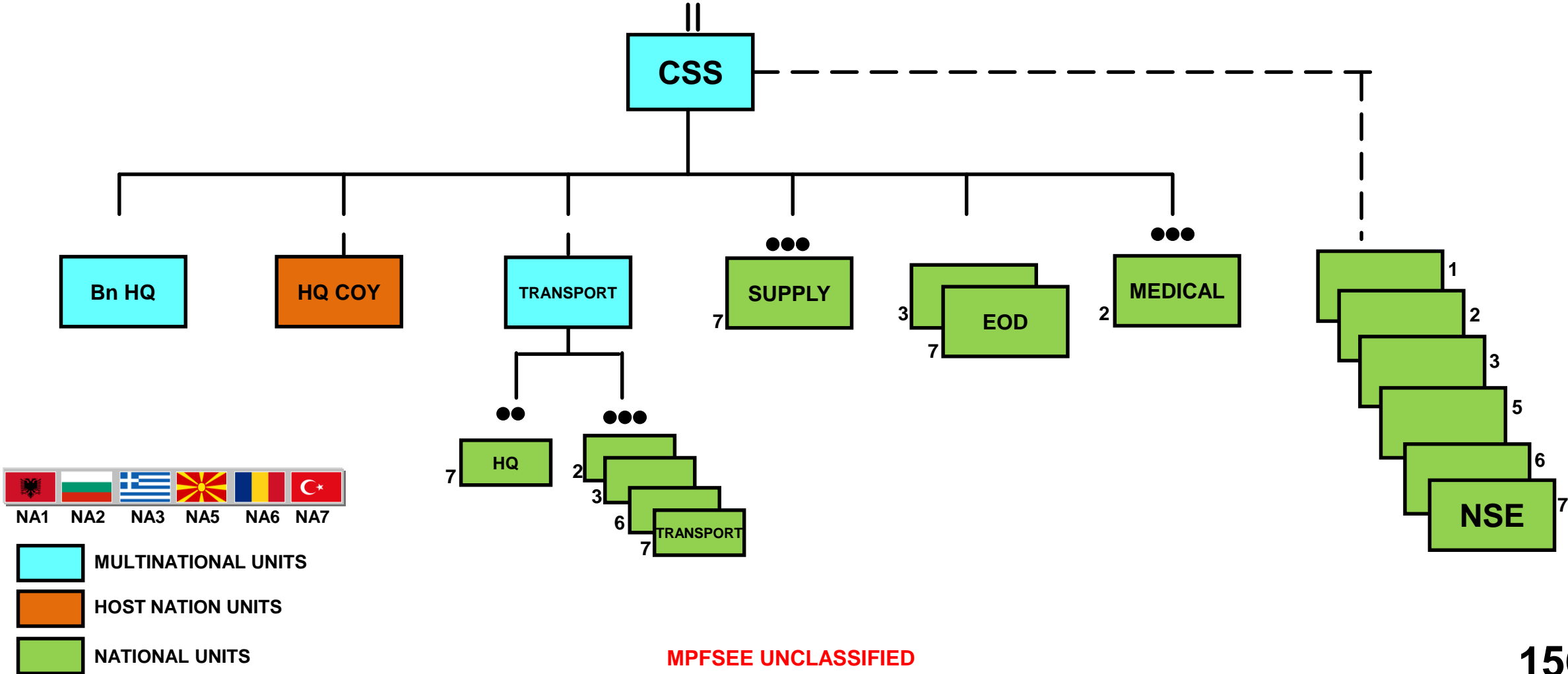


CONCEPT OF SUPPORT

- ❖ **SEEBRIG's Concept of Support is based on self-sustaining**
- ❖ **Ensures the support of national and multinational forces**
- ❖ **COMSEEBRIG coordinates the overall logistic effort to achieve the best sustainment of his operational plan**
- ❖ **Logistics support will be managed in phases in alignment with the operational plan**
- ❖ **Provision of logistics support is ultimately national responsibility**
 - **Bilateral or multilateral agreements, Lead Nation (LN), Role Specialist Nation (RSN) and Host Nation Support (HNS) will be used where possible, with the consensus of all Nations**
